The Steering Committee of the Ohio Roundup was called to order by Dennis Stamel, Chair, at 11:15, February 19, 1995 with the Serenity Prayer.

Each attendee introduced her/himself. Frank Wojcinski, delegate from Toledo was elected Co-Secretary by acclamation. He will become Secretary at the 1995 Dayton Roundup.

Howard Wilson, Akron, Treasurer gave the financial report. The delegates voted to keep \$5,000.00 in the account. That money is to cover \$2,000.00 for the next host city and \$3,000.00 for seed money. The motion was offered by the Secretary and seconded by Bonnie Beverage, Cincinnati.

Dayton delegates gave their report on the developing issues concerning the 1995 Roundup. It shall be entered into the By-Laws of the Charter that each city turn over the mailing list to the next city as quickly as possible when that roundup is completed. A computerized mailing list needs to be developed to help each city in transition. Dayton will mail to delegates fund-raiser events as they develop. The next fund-raiser is scheduled for March 17 in Dayton.

The delegates from Akron announced that committees have been developed for their petition to host the 1996 Roundup in their city. That presentation will be made during the Dayton roundup.

The next meeting of the Ohio Roundup Steering Committee is to be held at the same location in Columbus at 11:00 a.m., June 25, 1995. The Gay Pride Day parade kicks off at 1:00 p.m. that day from Goodale Park.

Dennis Stamel brought a number of items for the archives. More are still needed. Larry Thorne of Sidney has volunteered to help in the assembly of archive items which will be on display for the first time in Dayton
