**PROPOSAL TO AMEND CHARTER OF
OHIO STATE STEERING COMMITTEE**

Proposed amendment: to establish a scholarship fund from the state steering committee

Currently, the Ohio State Steering Committee charter establishes a fund for prudent reserves. In addition, the State Steering Committee receives any profits made from each roundup after all bills for the roundup have been paid. A portion of this money is allocated to the next year's roundup committee as "seed money" to assist the following year's roundup. The amount of seed money may be changed from time to time and currently stands at \$2,000.00. Any additional funds are split and allocated to such groups as World Services and International Advisory Council in keeping with the traditions.

The proposed amendment would:

- Establish a scholarship fund to help those who cannot attend the Roundup without financial assistance attend the roundup.
- The Scholarship fund will be established from any money left over after maintaining a prudent reserve and presenting next year's Roundup Committee with allocated seed money. Such fund will include any money left over at that time.
- The scholarship fund will be presented to the Roundup Committee hosting the next roundup during the February Steering Committee meeting.
- The scholarship fund is to be used according to the needs and priorities established by the Scholarship committee and the Executive Council hosting said Roundup. However, such money is not to be used to cover any costs incurred by the Roundup committee for supplying scholarships provided for in their bid for a roundup at the Steering Committee.
- Further, all money from the scholarship fund must be used to supply scholarships to the Ohio Roundup.
- No geographic limitations are to be placed on persons eligible for such scholarships.
