Bob R. called the meeting to order at 11:55 A.M.

Previous minutes:

• The committee reviewed and approved the minutes of the previous meeting.

Financial Report:

- Jim O. (on behalf of Judy F.) presented the spreadsheet with financial information to the committee. (See attachment 1.) Current balance totaled \$ 21,397.38.
- The treasurer's report was approved.

Toledo Committee 2009 Roundup:

• Jason K. handed out the final financial report (See attachment 2) to the committee and reported that the roundup was able to turn over revenue in access of the \$2,000 seed money in the amount of \$4,777.47 to the steering committee. Jason also handed over packets (containing pertinent information as required by the by-laws) to the Cleveland and Columbus committee from the 27th Ohio Roundup.

Cleveland Committee 2010 Roundup:

- Harry S announced fundraisers for NYE, Hay Ride, Movie Night, and Valentine's Dance among others and also said that the liability insurance has been addressed and will be taken care of.
- The NYE dance will be either at the Unitarian church or Zion.
- The website will be updated with all fund raising activities.
- Jim O stated that there was an issue with the website showing different conference dates then what the bid packets and magnets that were passed out at the August meeting had on them. Harry confirmed the dates to be August 20, 21 and 22nd, 2010. Jerry will correct the website.

• Frank reported that he anticipates that the Tax Exempt status will be reconciled by time of this year's roundup.

Columbus Committee 2011 Roundup:

- Steve K reported that the issue with setting up a fictitious name in order to open a checking account was resolved. Shannon S's name will be used as the primary contact on the account.
- A NYE dance is planned.
- Committee chairs are in place.
- Plan on having hotel by 1st of the year.
- Requested information from Toledo about the vendor at the Roundup.
- The vendor is Betty T. from the Yesterday and Today Shop, a local Toledo vendor. Someone from Toledo will get in contact with her to see if she would be interested in setting up her vendor's table at an out of town event.

Old Business:

Ohio Roundup Archives (ORAC) – Shannon announced that the inventory has been started.

- The ORAC should have a good idea about the inventory by February; the inventory is being stored in boxes by year.
- The ORAC will bring a box containing duplicates and also a box of items that they do not no what to do with to the Feb meeting.
- Shannon expressed that any extra help with the committee will be appreciated, he can send out an e-mail announcing the location, date and time of the next time the ORAC meets.

501(c)(3) update

- Frank reported that the accountant is in the process of investigating what it will take to apply for the 501(c)(3) status. There is no cost figure yet and he will have more information by February.
- Bob R asked if maybe we need to look into another accountant because of the confusion of the 501(c)(3) and 501(c)(4) status.
- Frank expressed that the current accountant did what we asked her to do and got our Tax Id reinstated and compliant. We have always been at a 501(c)(4) tax status.
- After further decision it was decided to proceed with the current accountant.

New Business:

Ohio Roundup Website

- Bob R asked that the website minutes page, which currently only has old out of date minutes, be updated with the current minutes. Currently the new minutes can only be found on the bottom of the Steering Committee Members' Page.
 - Jerry P. said that he will have the minute's page updated with all the minutes, both current and past.
- Shannon asked about the Pay Pal pages and if they are proof read. There were some pages that still referenced the Canton roundup for this year's roundup. This leads to confusion about which roundup you are paying for.

Jerry reminded the host committees that it is the host committee's responsibility to decide whether or not they want to use Pay Pal, if they do then it is their responsibility to proof read the pages to ensure that there are no mistakes.
