## 38th Ohio Roundup (Cleveland 2020) Host Update

Jeff R.

Prior to the presentation, Jeff R. presented to the group a brief history of the building and Gordon Square area that hosted the meeting. Vince

Jeff R., Host Committee Co-Chair, presented a written update. He also reported:

- The Committee has exceeded its fundraising goal by \$1,056.02.
- Expenses are approximately \$500 under budget due to donation of banner, magnets, and photocopying.
- The next fundraiser, a Drag Bingo event, is planned for Saturday, April 25 at 8:00 pm.
- Only 6 registrations have been received thus far. The budget is based on 90 early bird registrations, 30 standard full conference registrations, 10 workshop-only registrations, 10 banquet-only registrations, and 5 brunch-only registrations.
- The program committee, Scott & Jim, have been doing an outstanding job. Most of the leads have been secured. A gay male couple from Florida will provide the AA and Al-Anon leads Friday night. On Saturday, a lesbian rabbi from Chicago will lead. The Sunday brunch lead has yet to be finalized.
- The workshops will take place at 9:00 am and 10:30 am, and 1:00 pm and 2:30 pm on Saturday. There sill be 16 workshop sessions. Facilitators have been secured for 6 of the 16 workshops.
- Confirmed workshop topics so far include "Financial Sobriety," "Double Winners," "Step 11," and "Relationships in Recovery."
- Only one Al-Anon workshop presenter has been identified thus far.
- Entertainment options are being finalized. For Friday night, there will be a music group from Columbus, the *Twelve Steppers* that will provide a concert. There will also be a pool party, a recovery-themed movie, and a game room for Friday night. For Saturday, the entertainment options include a Dance, movie, and game room.
- Remaining tasks include hiring the taper, an interpreter, finalizing the menus, finalizing workshops and program, purchasing mugs/T-shirts, and getting volunteers for the Alkathon and hospitality room.

The Committee discussed the guidelines and precedence for having an ASL interpreter.

The Committee thanked Jeff for his update and commended the Cleveland Host Committee for a great job.

## 39th Ohio Roundup (Dayton 2021) Bid Update

- There already is a timeline document for host/bid committees. The Committee discussed cleaning and editing for potential publishing to the ORSC website. George C. will take a look at that timeline with Gerry P.

#### **New Business**

#### I. BANKING SIGNATORIES RESOLUTION and ORSC JUNE MEETING.

- Richard M. brought up the need to have the correct signatories on the Steering Committee Bank account.
- Currently, Richard M. and Jim O. are still signatories on the bank account. Harry S., Rhonda B., and Judy F. are currently not listed as signatories. Phil W. is the only proper signatory on the account.
- To change signatories, Huntington Bank requires all persons either being removed from the account or being added to the account must be present. There is no Huntington Bank branch open on Sundays.
- A resolution and a copy of the minutes must be presented to the bank upon changing signatories.
- Discussion was held about having the ORSC June meeting on Saturday, so that Harry S., Phil W., Rhonda B., Judy F., Jim O., and Richard M. could meet at a Huntington Bank Branch. This would require the bylaws to be suspended to hold the Saturday meeting, since the bylaws state the meeting shall be the first Sunday in June.
- Discussion was held about adding Judy F., ORSC Co-Chair, as a signatory on the checking account. Since we are halfway through the year, we should consider adding Judy F. to the list of signatories so that gathering the required signors together in a few months would not be required again.
